THE 2018 WORLD-WIDE BRIDGE CONTEST WILL BE HELD AT THE CLUB ON FRIDAY AFTERNOON, JUNE 7<sup>TH</sup> AND SATURDAY AFTERNOON, JUNE 8<sup>TH</sup>. THE HANDS WILL BE PRE-DEALT AND AFTER THE GAME A RECORD OF EACH HAND WILL BE AVAILABLE VIA AND EMAIL FROM THE ACBL. RED AND BLACK POINTS WILL BE AWARDED TO THE WINNERS AND RUNNERS-UP. FEES FOR THESE GAMES WILL BE \$14.00 FOR MEMBERS AND \$19.00 FOR NON-MEMBERS.

THE CLUB WILL ALSO HOST THE SECTIONAL-TOURNAMENT-AT-CLUB (STAC) GAMES FROM MONDAY, JUNE 3<sup>RD</sup> THROUGH SUNDAY, JUNE 9<sup>TH</sup>. HOWEVER, FRIDAY AND SATURDAY STAC GAMES WILL BE REPLACED BY THE WORLD-WIDE BRIDGE CONTEST DISCUSSED ABOVE.

ON WEDNESDAY EVENING, JUNE 26<sup>TH</sup>, THE CLUB WILL BE HAVING A SWISS TEAM GAME. THIS GAME IS A TEAM GAME AND THEREFORE REQUIRES FOUR PEOPLE ON EACH TEAM. PIZZA WILL BE AVAILABLE BEFORE THE GAME. WE HAVE A SIGN-UP SHEET POSTED AT THE CLUB. PLAYER MAY SIGN UP AS SINGLES OR PAIRS. WE WILL TRY TO PAIR SINGLE PLAYERS. THE COM[POSITION OF THE TEAMS WILL BE DETERMINED BY THE CUMMULATIVE MASTERPOINTS OF EACH PLAYER. THE GAME WILL BE PART OF THE ACBL'S "THE LONGEST DAY" CAMPAIGN FOR A CURE FOR ALZHEIMER'S DISEASE. FEES FOR THIS GAME WILL BE \$15 FOR MEMBERS AND \$20 FOR NON-MEMBERS.

PLAYERS ARE ASKED TO KEEP THEIR HANDS OFF THE TABLE WHEN THEY ARE DUMMY. IF THE DUMMY WISHES TO CORRECT AN ERRONEOUS LEAD BY THE DECLARER, HE SHOULD ANNOUNCE THIS FACT, RATHER THAN BANGING ON THE TABLE.

THE APRIL/MAY OPEN GAMES PLAYER-OF-THE-MONTH WAS MICAEL GECHT. HE WAS FOLLOWED BY JIM FAZZOLARI, HERMAN ZEIGER, STU EDELSTEIN, MARTY FLANZBAUM, SHELLY AMIN, JERRY PINSKER, MICHAEL DESTEFANIS, AND DIANE LEPRO. THE 0-299 GAMES PLAYER-OF-THE-MONTH WAS SANGITA MEHTA, SHE WAS FOLLOWED BY HODA KASSOUF, LUCIA TAYLOR, PHIL BLITZ, BERNIE SCHRADER, MYLES GOLDBER, EILEEN LOSTETTER, OLIVIA BRENNAN, BETTY KASEGRANDE AND TARYN MANDEL.

WE HAD ONE PAIR WHO ACHIEVED A 70% OR BETTER GAME. PANKAJ MEHTA AND SERENA DAY SCORED A 70.23% GAME.

WHEN PLAYING A HOWELL MOVEMENT (WHERE EVERYBODY MOVES), IT IS VERY IMPORTANT THAT THE NORTH PLAYER MAKES SURE THAT THE BRIDGEMATE DOES NOT SHOW THE RESULTS OF THE LAST HAND OF THE PREVIOUS ROUND. PLEASE PRESS "OK" UNTIL THE LAST HAND RECORD DISAPPEARS.

THE WATER COOLER RECEPTICLE DOES NOT HAVE A DRAIN SO LIQUIDS SHOULD NOT BE Poured INTO IT.

IF YOU HAVE BRIDGE LIBRARY BOOKS OUT ON LOAN AND YOU HAVE FORGOTTEN ABOUT THEM, PLEASE RETURN THEM TO THE CLUB.

A DETERMINATION TO HAVE A SUNDAY AFTERNOON GAME WILL DEPEND ON HOW MANY PEOPLE SIGN UP AS OF SATURDAY AFTERNOON.
