RECENTLY THERE HAVE BEEN PROBLEMS WITH PLAYERS MAKING CLAIMS. THE ACBL RULES STATE THAT ONCE A CLAIM IS MADE, ALL PLAY STOPS AND THE DECLARER'S HAND IS EXPOSED. HOWEVER, IN ORDER TO PROTECT HIS CLAIM, THE DECLARER MUST TELL THE OPPONENTS HOW HE PLANS TO PLAY THE REST OF THE CARDS. IF THIS IS NOT DONE, THE DEFENDERS ARE ENTITLED TO A TRICK OR TRICKS ON A REASONABLE LINE OF PLAY. THE RULES ARE MORE STRINGENT WHEN THE DEFENDERS HAVE AN OUTSTANDING TRUMP. THESE RULES ARE MORE LIKELY TO FAVOR THE DEFENDERS. ALTHOUGH WE ARE ASKING PLAYERS TO BE CAREFUL WHEN CLAIMING, WE ARE ALSO ENCOURAGING DECLARERS TO MAKE CLAIMS WHEN IT IS OBVIOUS THAT THEY HAVE ALL THE REMAINING TRICKS. FOR INSTANCE, IF YOU HAVE ALL THE REMAINING TRUMP THERE IS NO POINT IN PLAYING EVERY SINGLE CARD.

WE HAD THREE PAIRS THAT SCORED A 70% OR BETTER GAME DURING THE MONTH OF MARCH. MYLES GOLDBERG AND PHIL BLITZ HAD A 75.78% GAME, PANKAJ MEHTA AND COLETTE GRILLO HAD A 70% GAME AND MARTY FLANZBAUM AND STU EDELSTEIN HAD A 70.23% GAME.

BEGINNING APRIL  $1^{ST}$ , 70% GAMES MUST BE EARNED IN A GAME OF FIVE TABLES OR MORE IN ORDER TO WIN A FREE PLAY.
